

## Locating your 'lost' superannuation

Due to people changing jobs, every working person has an average of 2.3 accounts per person. And many lose track of them. In fact, by 2005/06 5.7 million super accounts were unclaimed, holding \$9.7 billion in funds.

To find out if you have lost any superannuation, use the Australian Taxation Office's SuperSeeker service to find them.

The phone number for the ATO's SuperSeeker service is **13 28 65**.

Alternatively, you can visit the ATO's website ([www.ato.gov.au](http://www.ato.gov.au)) and follow the links '**For Superannuation/Find your lost super**'

Before you can go any further, make sure you have your Tax File Number with you. You will also be asked for your name and date of birth.

Your superannuation is one of your most important assets. Don't leave it with the Tax Office to enjoy.
